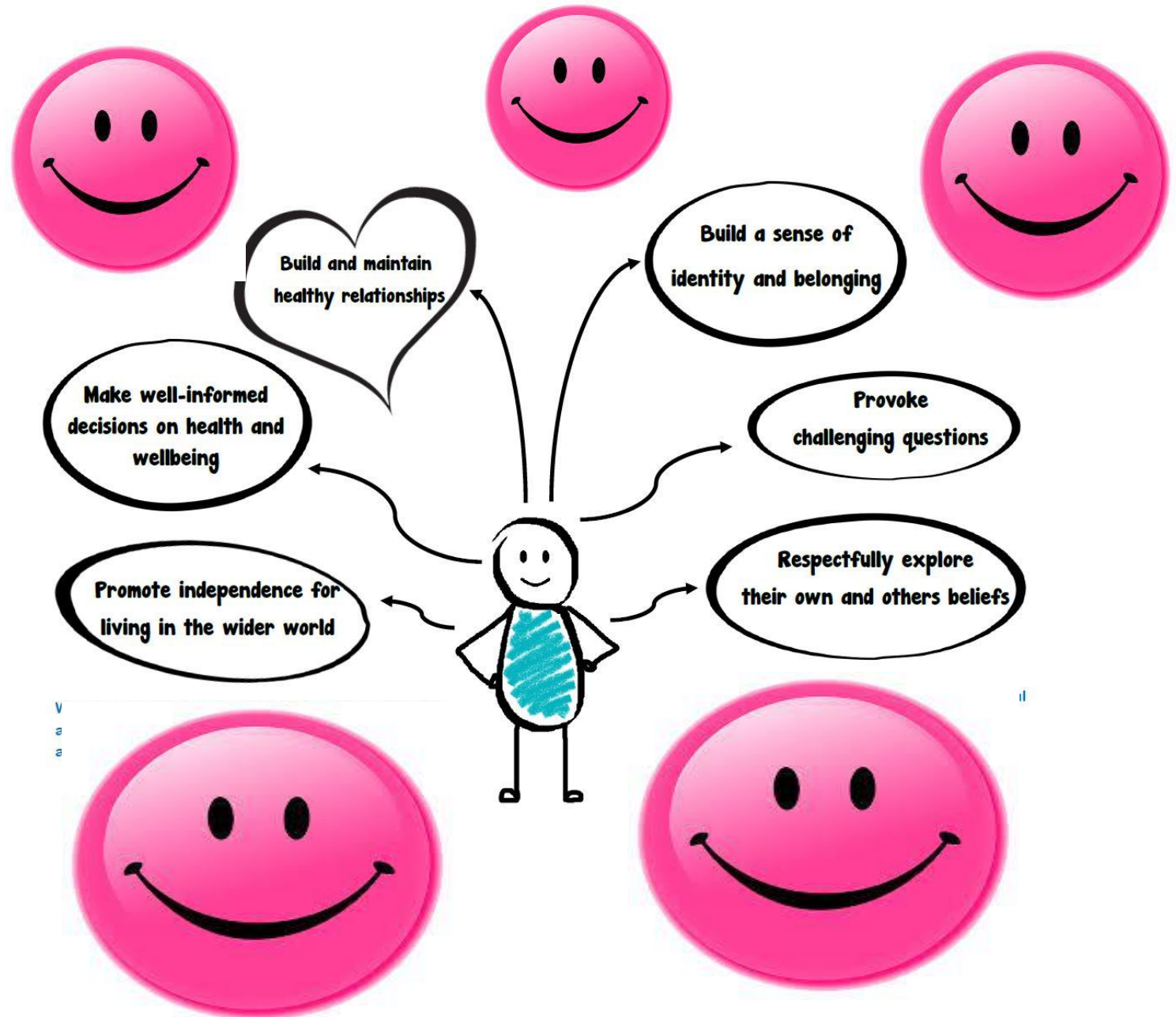
Personal, Social and Health Education

PSHE THREE CORE THEMES

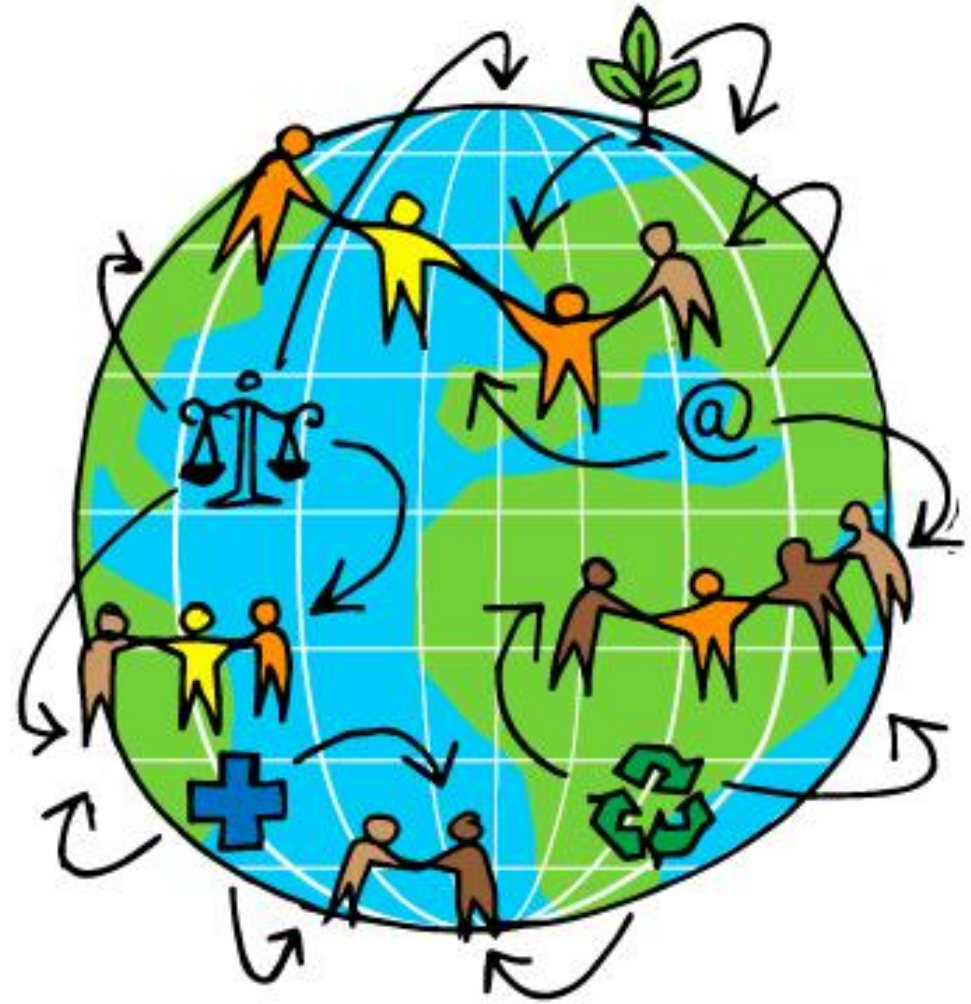
- ✓ Health and well-being
