Our Focus

Data Defending

Did you know that apps and websites aimed at children collect more information than those aimed at adults? The information collected tends to be our personal data. This is any information that is personal to you like your location, telephone number, appearance, IP address or home address. Remember once your data is shared online, it will be sold to companies and advertised by a data broker.

Tips to stay safe

- Never fill in any forms online without parental consent.
- Only use and click on reliable websites (these websites are trusted and demonstrate good performance).
- Do not share payment details or attempt to pay for something online without parental consent.
- Do not share information regarding you (sometimes you need to think if the information the website is asking for is required for you to view the contents of the website, for example, to watch Newsround they do not require your home address or appearance).
