Learning Focus

Reading - Engage in longer stories.

Giganticsaurus by Jonny Duddle

Phonics— Little Wandle—blending, initial sounds and environmental sounds.

Maths - Mastering numbers to 2. Comparing groups using vocabulary such as more, less.

RE— Easter, St George's Day and Eid

PSHE - Looking at our body and keeping healthy. Start tooth brushing in school.

Computing— Digital Literacy—using iPads, microphones and 2paint to draw and retell out favourite stories.

PE— Exploring different ways of moving. Listening and stopping. Climbing and balancing. Freezing and following instructions.

DT/Science/ Art – Looking at flowers, seeds and plants. Discussing and observation of plants. Discussing what we observe and asking questions.

Music - Learning new rhymes and beginning to make our own up.

History—Looking at past and future journeys. Sharing memories from places with our family.

Books—Giganticsaurus, traditional tale such as Goldilocks and the Three Bears and the children's favourite stories such as Peppa Pig.
