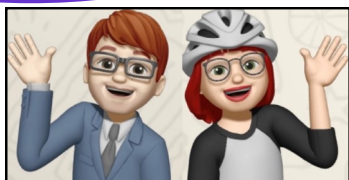
Homework Suggestions
